# OFFICIAL MINUTES CLEARWATER RIVER WATERSHED DISTRICT BOARD OF MANAGERS BUDGET HEARING June 21, 2023 – 6:00 PM

**1. Call to Order** A regular meeting for the Clearwater River Watershed District was called to order via zoom at 6:03 PM, Wednesday, June 21, 2023 by Chair Schiefelbein.

## 2. Adopt Agenda

Motion by Cole second by Homuth to adopt the agenda as edited. *Motion 23-06-1* carried unanimously via call of roll.

#### 3. Presentations

- a. Clearwater Harbor Clogs- Carlson and Septic Check provided details on clogging at lift station 19 and failures at list station 3 as well as steps taken. Motion by Cole, second by Uecker to authorize Septic Check to initiate repairs identified which include \$2200 for an electrical amp overload cutout in Lift station 19; \$2010 for a new impeller and wear ring on pump 2 lift station 19 and \$2,275 for a new impeller and wear ring on lift station 3 pump 2. Motion 23-06-2 carried unanimously via call of roll.
  - Septic Check will provide review of historical impeller/ pump replacement timing to determine future maintenance schedules.
- b. **Beechwood Road-** Staff updated the managers on the issues at Beechwood Road and advised of the coming meeting. No action.
- c. **Hydrology, Bog Update-** Staff updated the board on hydrology and District from worry over high water and bogs, to worry over low water and poor water quality.
